The LIS PYP visual art program runs concurrently and in collaboration with units of inquiry, but may also take its own path at times. Students engage all learner profile skills across the year in diverse art based activities. There are opportunities to try different materials and apply them in different ways, ranging from abstract, expressionistic and experimental methods, to traditional drawing, painting and model making skills. Students aim to develop a range of skills through observing demonstrations, experimentation, practice and being introduced to different art forms and approaches. They are encouraged to develop confidence in applying verbal, physical and visual communication skills. They explore and express ideas as well as debate and analyze concepts through group and individual work.
